# Index and overview of findings



#### **Data Source**

This report is based on the experience of 534 people. Feedback has been obtained from a variety of sources, including general engagement and comments posted online (including Care Opinion, NHS and social media). More on page 4.



### **Overall Satisfaction**

Satisfaction has improved by 3% this quarter, standing at 78% positive, 21% negative and 1% neutral.

Feedback suggests people receive good quality, compassionate treatment and care on the whole, with good levels of involvement, communication and support. Service access remains as a leading negative topic. More on page 5.



## Information, Involvement and Support

Satisfaction has improved by 2% this quarter, standing at 84% positive, 15% negative and 1% neutral.

Complaints are down by 4% on support and by 3% on user involvement, while up marginally by 1% on communication. More on page 5.



## **Quality and Empathy**

Comments suggest satisfaction has improved by 3%, standing at 88% positive and 12% negative.

People continue to report good levels of quality and empathy across services. *More on page 5*.



### **Access to Services**

Satisfaction has improved by 4% this quarter, standing at 46% positive, 51% negative and 3% neutral.

Complaints are down by 6% on telephone access, by 5% on ability to book appointments and by 3% on waiting times. More on page 5.

### **GP Services**

Satisfaction is at 67% positive, 32% negative and 1% neutral, comments suggest.

165 people comment on GP services. Feedback suggests good quality, compassionate treatment and care, with good levels of involvement and support. Ability to book appointments, waiting times, telephones and administration remain as leading access related issues. More on page 9.



### **Dentists**

According to comments, sentiment is 92% positive and 8% negative.

283 people comment on dentists, with accounts of excellent treatment, care and customer service recorded. Good levels of information and involvement are also reported. More on page 10.




## Northwick Park Hospital


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


#### 2. Health and Care Services: Which service aspects are people most commenting on?






